

Financing road maintenance and managing the road maintenance funds

Participants must have a good knowledge of the basic concepts of economy applied to the road projects.

Context - Objectives

The question of the financing of the road does end just in a one-time investment decision. It is a permanent stake, since it is a question of guaranteeing sufficient and stable resources to meet the long-term needs for a whole network. During this time of deep changes, it is a major topic of the Initiative for the Management of Road (IGR), one of the components of the SSATP (*Sub-Saharan Transport Policy Program*) of the World Bank.

This formation, in French language, is carried out in collaboration with the IGR, and the University of Birmingham which organizes an English seminar "Senior Road Executives Management" including this same topic (in Spring 2005).

This session will allow the participants:

- to develop the stakes of the changes in progress, to define measurements and actions to be set up, and to defend them,
- to identify the parameters which determine the needs for financing, and to characterize these needs in the duration,
- to compare and choose methods of financing, adapted to the desired strategy of maintenance,
- to include/understand the economic and institutional principles, as well as the different methods of management the various types road funds,
- to identify the sources of financing possible, public and private, local or external and to include/understand their advantages,
- to carry out the study of the needs for financing,
- to define the criteria of evaluation of a system of financing.
